

ADVERTISEMENT FOR BIDS

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Sealed bids will be received at the Village of Botkins, 210 South Mill Street, Botkins, Ohio 45306 until 10:00 A.M. (local time), on Thursday, August 21, 2014 for furnishing all labor equipment, and materials necessary to complete the project known as **Lift Station Rehabilitation**. The bids will then be publicly opened and read aloud in the Council Chambers. The work for which proposals are invited includes rehabilitation of an existing lift station to include, but not be limited to, installation of all equipment supplied by Owner and the furnishing of all other labor, equipment, and materials in accordance with the detailed construction plans to complete a fully functional and operational station.

Contract Documents including Specifications and the Plans may be examined and obtained at the office of Mote & Associates, Inc., 214 West Fourth Street, Greenville, Ohio 45331. A non-refundable charge for each set of the Plans and Contract Documents will be required in the amount of **\$35.00**. An additional non-refundable handling charge of **\$10.00** will be required if documents are to be shipped. **Proposals will only be accepted from bidders who have purchased Contract Documents (including Plans and Specifications) from Mote & Associates, Inc. and have been registered as a planholder.**

A Pre-Bid Conference will be held on Thursday, August 14, 2014 at 10:00 A.M. at the Council Chambers located at the Village Office, 210 South Mill Street, Botkins, Ohio. All bidders are encouraged to attend since written comments will only be distributed as an Addendum, if deemed necessary by the Engineer.

Each bidder is required to furnish with its proposal, a Bid Guaranty and Contract Bond in accordance with Section 153.54 of the Ohio Revised Code. Bid security furnished in Bond form, shall be issued by a Surety Company or Corporation licensed in the State of Ohio to provide said surety. Each Proposal must contain the full name of the party or parties submitting the Proposal and all persons interested therein. Each bidder must submit evidence of its experiences on projects of similar size and complexity, and a complete listing of all subcontractors to be used. No bidder may withdraw his bid within sixty (60) days after the actual date of the opening thereof.

All contractors and subcontractors involved with the project will, to the extent practicable, use Ohio products, materials, services, and labor in the implementation of this project. Additionally, Contractor compliance with the equal employment opportunity requirements of Ohio Administrative Code Chapter 123 is required.

Bidders must comply with the prevailing wage rates on Public Improvements in Shelby County and the Village of Botkins as determined by the Ohio Department of Commerce, Bureau of Wage and Hour Administration, 614-644-2239 and included herein.

The Village of Botkins reserves the right to accept or reject any or all proposals, to waive any informalities in the bidding, and to enter into a contract with the bidder whom in their consideration offered the lowest and best proposal.
