

ADVERTISEMENT FOR BIDS

Sealed bids will be received at the Village of Castine, 218 North Main Street, Castine, Ohio 45304 until 2:00 P.M. (local time), on Friday, April 11, 2014, for furnishing all labor, materials, and equipment necessary to complete the project known as **Main Street Reconstruction**. **The Village of Castine's Village Hall does not have regular office hours. Delivery of bids via the United States Postal Service or a delivery service (i.e., UPS, Fed-Ex, etc.) must specify delivery by 1:00 P.M. on Friday, April 11, 2014 to Mayor Mary E. Brown, 246 N. Main Street, Castine, Ohio 45304. The Village Hall will open at 1:15 P.M. on Friday, April 11, 2014 for the acceptance of bids. The bids will be publicly opened and read aloud at 2:00 PM. on that date at the Village Hall.**

The work for which proposals are invited includes the reconstruction of ±2,500 L.F. of asphaltic street including concrete curb and gutter, concrete sidewalks, concrete driveway approaches, storm sewers, and appurtenances. This project excludes construction of the asphalt base, intermediate, and surface courses which will be subsequently constructed by another contract administered by the Ohio Department of Transportation.

Contract Documents including Specifications and the Plans may be examined and obtained at the office of Mote & Associates, Inc., 214 West Fourth Street, Greenville, Ohio 45331. A non-refundable charge for each set of the Plans and Contract Documents will be required in the amount of \$130.00. An additional non-refundable handling charge of \$10.00 will be required if documents are to be shipped. **Proposals will only be accepted from bidders who have purchased Contract Documents (including Plans and Specifications) from Mote & Associates, Inc. and have been registered as a planholder.**

A Pre-Bid Conference will be held on Thursday, April 3, 2014 at 10:00 A.M. at the Castine Village Hall, 218 N. Main Street, Castine, Ohio. All bidders are encouraged to attend since written comments will only be distributed as an Addendum, if deemed necessary by the Engineer.

Each bidder is required to furnish with its proposal, a Bid Guaranty and Contract Bond in accordance with Section 153.54 of the Ohio Revised Code. Bid security furnished in Bond form, shall be issued by a Surety Company or Corporation licensed in the State of Ohio to provide said surety. Each Proposal must contain the full name of the party or parties submitting the Proposal and all persons interested therein. Each bidder must submit evidence of its experiences on projects of similar size and complexity, and a complete listing of all subcontractors to be used. The Owner intends and requires that the project be completed no later than **Friday, September 26, 2014**. No bidder may withdraw his bid within sixty (60) days after the actual date of the opening thereof.

All contractors and subcontractors involved with the project will, to the extent practicable, use Ohio products, materials, services, and labor in the implementation of this project. Additionally, Contractor compliance with the equal employment opportunity requirements of Ohio Administrative Code Chapter 123 is required.

Bidders must comply with the prevailing wage rates on Public Improvements in Darke County and the Village of Castine as determined by the Ohio Department of Commerce, Bureau of Wage and Hour Administration, 614-644-2239 and included herein.

The Village of Castine reserves the right to accept or reject any or all proposals, to waive any informalities in the bidding, and to enter into a contract with the bidder whom in their consideration offered the lowest and best proposal.
