

ADVERTISEMENT FOR BIDS

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Sealed bids will be received at the Village of Union City, 419 East Elm Street, Union City, Ohio 45390 until 10:00 A.M. (local time), on Thursday, March 13, 2014 for furnishing all labor, materials, and equipment necessary to complete the project known as **Sanitary Sewer Rehabilitation Phase III.** The bids will then be publicly opened and read aloud. The work for which proposals are invited consists of approximately 11,220 L.F. of cured-in-place pipe lining along with manhole rehabilitation and all related appurtenances.

Contract Documents including Specifications and the Plans may be examined at the office of the Village of Union City, 419 East Elm Street, Union City, Ohio 45390 and obtained at the office of Mote & Associates, Inc., 214 West Fourth Street, Greenville, Ohio 45331. A non-refundable charge for each set of the Plans and Contract Documents will be required in the amount of \$40.00. An additional non-refundable handling charge of \$10.00 will be required if documents are to be shipped. **Proposals will only be accepted from bidders who have purchased Contract Documents (including Plans and Specifications) and have been registered as a plan holder with Mote & Associates, Inc.**

Each bidder is required to furnish with its proposal, a Bid Guaranty and Contract Bond in accordance with Section 153.54 of the Ohio Revised Code. Bid security furnished in Bond form, shall be issued by a Surety Company or Corporation licensed in the State of Ohio to provide said surety. Each Proposal must contain the full name of the party or parties submitting the Proposal and all persons interested therein. Each bidder must submit evidence of its experiences on the projects of similar size and complexity, and a complete listing of all subcontractors to be used. The Owner intends and requires that the project be completed no later than June 30, 2014. No bidder may withdraw his bid within sixty (60) days after the actual date of the opening thereof.

All contractors and subcontractors involved with the project will, to the extent practicable, use Ohio products, materials, services, and labor in the implementation of this project. Additionally, Contractor compliance with the equal employment opportunity requirements of Ohio Administrative Code Chapter 123 is required.

Bidders must comply with the prevailing wage rates on Public Improvements in Darke County and the Village of Union City as determined by the Ohio Department of Commerce, Bureau of Wage and Hour Administration, 614-644-2239 and included herein.

DOMESTIC STEEL USE REQUIREMENTS AS SPECIFIED IN SECTION 153.011 OF THE REVISED CODE APPLY TO THIS PROJECT. COPIES OF SECTION 153.011 OF THE REVISED CODE CAN BE OBTAINED FROM THE OFFICE OF THE OHIO FACILITIES CONSTRUCTION COMMISSION. Steel products is defined in Revised Code Section 153.011 as: "...products rolled, formed, shaped, drawn, extruded, forge, cast, fabricated or otherwise similarly processed.....and used for load-bearing structural purposes...."
