

## ADVERTISEMENT FOR BIDS

*A project funded by CDBG funds*

Sealed proposals will be received by the Darke County Board of Commissioners (Contracting Authority) on behalf of the Village of Union City, Ohio (Owner) at the Darke County Board of Commissioners, Administration Building, 520 South Broadway, Greenville, Ohio 45331 until **1:00 p.m. (local time) on Wednesday, March 26, 2014** for furnishing all labor, materials, and equipment necessary to complete the project known as the **Village of Union City – Deerfield Road Reconstruction** project. The bids will be publicly opened and read aloud during regular session of the same day beginning at 1:30 p.m. The work for which proposals are invited consists of roadway reconstruction between Elm Street and Main Street, along with the installation of approximately 1,539 S.F. of sidewalk, 791 L.F. of curb and gutter, and 200 L.F. of 12” storm sewer and all related appurtenances.

Contract Documents including specifications and the plans may be examined at the office of the Village of Union City, 419 East Elm Street, Union City, Ohio 45390 (Monday through Thursday) or obtained at the office of the Consulting Engineer, Mote & Associates, Inc., 214 West Fourth Street, Greenville, Ohio 45331. A non-refundable charge for each set of the Plans and Contract Documents will be required in the amount of **\$60.00**. An additional non-refundable handling charge of **\$10.00** will be required if documents are to be shipped. **Proposals will only be accepted from bidders who have obtained Contract Documents (including plans and specifications) from Mote & Associates, Inc. and have been registered as a planholder.**

A Pre-Bid Conference will be held on Tuesday, March 18, 2014 at 10:00 AM at the Darke County Commissioners Conference Room located at 520 South Broadway, Greenville, Ohio. All Bidders are encouraged to attend since written comments will only be distributed as an Addendum, if deemed necessary by the Engineer.

Each bidder is required to furnish with its proposal a 100% Bid Guaranty and Contract Bond or a certified check, or a cashier's check upon a solvent bank in the amount of 10% of the bid in accordance with Section 153.54 of the Ohio Revised Code. Bid security furnished in Bond form shall be issued by a Surety Company or Corporation licensed in the State of Ohio to provide said surety. Each Proposal must contain the full name of the party or parties submitting the proposal and all persons interested therein. Each bidder must submit evidence of its experience on projects of similar size and complexity along with a complete list of all subcontractors to be used. The Owner intends and requires substantial project completion no later than **September 30, 2014**.

Additionally, attention of bidders is called to all of the requirements contained in the Contract Documents and on the plans, particularly to the Federal Labor Standards Provisions including the Davis-Bacon Prevailing Wage Rates, various insurance requirements, various equal opportunity provisions, and the requirement for a 100% Performance and Payment Bond. No bidder may withdraw his bid within sixty days after the actual date of the opening thereof.

DOMESTIC STEEL USE REQUIREMENTS AS SPECIFIED IN SECTION 153.011 OF THE REVISED CODE APPLY TO THIS PROJECT. COPIES OF SECTION 153.011 OF THE REVISED CODE CAN BE OBTAINED FROM THE OFFICE OF THE OHIO FACILITIES CONSTRUCTION COMMISSION. Steel products is defined in Revised Code Section 153.011 as: "...products rolled, formed, shaped, drawn, extruded, forge, cast, fabricated or otherwise similarly processed.....and used for load-bearing structural purposes...."

The Darke County Board of Commissioners and the Village of Union City reserve the right to accept or reject any or all bids, to waive any informalities in the bidding, and to enter into a contract with the bidder who, in their consideration, offered the lowest and best bid.
