ADVERTISEMENT FOR BIDS

Sealed Bids will be received by the Darke County Board of Commissioners (Contracting Authority) on behalf of the Village of Union City, Ohio (Owner) at the Darke County Board of Commissioners, Administration Building, 520 South Broadway, Greenville, Ohio 45331 until **1:00 PM (local time) on April 26, 2017** for furnishing all labor, materials, and equipment necessary to complete the project known as **Village of Union City - First Street Resurfacing with Subgrade Stabilization**. The Bids received will be publicly opened and read aloud during the Regular Session on the same day beginning at 1:30 PM. The work for which proposals are invited consists of cement stabilization and asphalt resurfacing of approximately 1,035 L.F. of street along with an Alternate Bid to extend the project an additional 670 L.F.

The Contract Documents including Specifications may be examined or obtained from the Issuing Office of the Consulting Engineer, Mote & Associates, Inc., 214 West Fourth Street, Greenville, Ohio 45331 (937.548.7511). A non-refundable charge for the Contract Documents will be required in the amount of \$35.00 per set, payable to Mote & Associates, Inc. An additional non-refundable handling charge of **\$15.00** will be required if documents are to be shipped. An electronic version of the Contract Documents is also available for a non-refundable charge of \$25.00. The Owner and/or Engineer will not be responsible for full or partial sets of Bidding Documents, including Addenda if any, obtained from sources other than the Engineer. **Proposals will only be accepted from bidders who have purchased the Contract Documents from Mote & Associates, Inc. and are registered as a planholder.**

Each Bidder is required to furnish with its proposal a 100% Bid Guaranty and Contract Bond or a certified check upon a solvent bank in the amount of 10% of the total bid amount in accordance with Section 153.54 of the Ohio Revised Code. Bid security furnished in Bond form shall be issued by a Surety Company or Corporation licensed in the State of Ohio to provide said surety. Each Proposal must contain the full name of the party or parties submitting the Proposal and all persons interested therein. Each Bidder must submit evidence of its experience on projects of similar size and complexity. The Owner intends and requires that the project be completed no later than **July 31, 2017**.

Additionally, attention of bidders is called to all of the requirements contained in the Contract Documents and on the plans, particularly to the Federal Labor Standards Provisions including the Davis-Bacon Prevailing Wage Rates, various insurance requirements, various equal opportunity provisions, and the requirement for a 100% Performance and Payment Bond. No bidder may withdraw his bid within sixty (60) days after the actual date of the opening thereof.

The Darke County Board of Commissioners and the Village of Union City reserve the right to accept or reject any or all bids, to waive any informalities in the bidding, and to enter into a contract with the bidder whom in their consideration offered the lowest and best proposal.
