

ADVERTISEMENT FOR BIDS

A project funded with CDBG funds

Sealed bids will be received at the Village of Verona, 100 West Main Street, Verona, Ohio 45378 until 10:00 A.M. (local time), on Tuesday, January 28, 2014, for furnishing all labor, materials, and equipment necessary to complete the project known as **Main Street Water Line Replacement Phase II**. The bids will then be publicly opened and read aloud. The work for which proposals are invited consists of replacement of approximately 500 L.F. of existing water line on Main Street between Mill Street and Harrison Street.

A **pre-bid meeting** will be held on Friday, January 17, 2014 at 2:00 P.M. at the Village of Verona, 100 West Main Street, Verona, Ohio 45378.

Contract Documents including specifications and the plans may be examined at the office of the Village of Verona, 100 West Main Street, Verona, Ohio 45378 or obtained at the office of Mote & Associates, Inc., 214 West Fourth Street, Greenville, Ohio 45331. A non-refundable charge for each set of Plans and Contract Documents will be required in the amount of \$40.00. **Proposals will only be accepted from bidders who have obtained Contract Documents (including plans and specifications) from Mote & Associates, Inc. and have been registered as a planholder.**

Each bidder is required to furnish with its proposal, a Bid Guaranty and Contract Bond in accordance with Section 153.54 of the Ohio Revised Code. Bid security furnished in Bond form, shall be issued by a Surety Company or Corporation licensed in the State of Ohio to provide said surety with the Bidder named as Principal. Each Proposal must contain the full name of the party or parties submitting the proposal and all persons interested therein. Each bidder must submit evidence of its experiences on projects of similar size and complexity, and a complete listing of all subcontractors to be used.

The Owner intends and requires that substantial construction be completed by Friday, May 30, 2014.

Additionally, attention of bidders is called to all of the requirements contained in the Contract Documents and on the plans, particularly to the Federal Labor Standards Provisions including the Davis-Bacon Prevailing Wage Rates, various insurance requirements, various equal opportunity provisions, and the requirement for a 100% Performance and Payment Bond. No bidder may withdraw his bid within sixty (60) days after the actual date of the opening thereof.

Contractor shall be paid for completion of the work in accordance with the contract documents and funding requirements from a Community Development Block Grant (CDBG).

All contractors and subcontractors involved with the project will, to the extent practicable, use Ohio products, materials, services, and labor in the implementation of this project. Additionally, Contractor compliance with the equal employment opportunity requirements of Ohio Administrative Code Chapter 123, the Governor's Executive Order 1972, and the Governor's Executive Order 84-9 shall be required.

DOMESTIC STEEL USE REQUIREMENTS AS SPECIFIED IN SECTION 153.011 OF THE REVISED CODE APPLY TO THIS PROJECT. COPIES OF SECTION 153.011 OF THE REVISED CODE CAN BE OBTAINED FROM THE OFFICE OF THE OHIO FACILITIES CONSTRUCTION COMMISSION. Steel products is defined in Revised Code Section 153.011 as: "...products rolled, formed, shaped, drawn, extruded, forge, cast, fabricated or otherwise similarly processed.....and used for load-bearing structural purposes...."

The Village of Verona reserves the right to accept or reject any or all proposals, to waive any informalities in the bidding, and to enter into a contract with the bidder whom in their consideration offered the lowest and best proposal.
