(local time) on Tuesday, June 29, 2021** for furnishing all labor, materials, and equipment necessary to complete the project known as <u>Ohio City</u> <u>West Side Storm Sewer Improvements.</u> The bids received will then be publicly opened and read aloud. The work for which proposals are invited consists of construction of a storm water detention basin as well as installation of approximately 5,825 L.F. of 8" through 48" storm sewer with 2 manholes, 34 catch basins, and all related appurtenances.

Each bidder is required to furnish with its proposal, a Bid Guaranty and Contract Bond in accordance with Section 153.54 of the Ohio Revised Code. Bid security furnished in Bond form, shall be issued by a Surety Company or Corporation licensed in the State of Ohio to provide said surety. Each Proposal must contain the full name of the party or parties submitting the Proposal and all persons interested therein. Each bidder must submit evidence of its experiences on the projects of similar size and complexity. The Owner intends and requires that the project be completed no later than **June 30, 2022**.
