Scholarship Overview (2023-2024)

Introduction:	The name of the merit-based, non-renewable scholarship herein created shall be known as the "Mote & Associates, Inc. Scholarship." The intention of the Mote & Associates, Inc. Scholarship is to assist commendable students in the attainment of their post high school education in a career in the field of Engineering, Surveying, Architecture, or closely related field of study. The objective of the scholarship is (1) to encourage studies in the field of Engineering, Surveying, Architecture, or closely related field of study, (2) to provide additional incentive and career motivation in the field of Engineering, Surveying, Architecture, or closely related field of study, (3) to enhance and promote the professions of Engineering, Surveying, Architecture, or closely related field of study, and (4) to award the scholarship to a student to further their education and enhance their employability in the field of Engineering, Surveying, Architecture, or closely related field of study.
Award:	One or more scholarships will be awarded in the amount of one thousand dollars (\$1,000.00) each. The scholarship check will be made payable to the student and is to be used for tuition and/or other fees.
Eligibility:	Applicant(s) selected to receive such funds will be, at the time, a Senior in high school scheduled to graduate on time with his or her class or a college undergraduate. The applicant(s) must be pursuing an undergraduate degree/certificate at a four-year university/college, a two-year junior college, and/or a post high school technical school with the intent to pursue a career in the field of Engineering, Surveying, Architecture, or closely related field of study.
Selection Criteria:	The recipient will be selected by Mote & Associates, Inc. He or she should exemplify the following criteria: 1) Goals and aspirations in the field of Engineering, Surveying, Architecture, or closely related field of study. 2) Involvement in the community and school demonstrating leadership, interpersonal skills, and social responsibility. 3) Academic ability and motivation to succeed. A personal interview may be requested of the top three applicants.
